Regular Council Meeting– November 1, 2022

Century Heights Water System Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Open House

The Environmental Assessment Process (EA) for the expansion of the Century Heights Water System is moving forward. The well has been drilled, pump tests have occurred, and the Source Water Protection committee is reviewing the findings. An Open House style meeting will take place on Thursday, December 1, 2022, and will feature display boards, that are prepared by our Engineers, B.M. Ross & Associates, and a presentation with time for questions and comments after. Community Emergency Management Coordinator

Council appointed Chad Kregar as the Community Emergency Management Coordinator for the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh. Chad is employed by the Corporation of the County of Huron's Emergency Services Department and oversees the review and maintenance of the mandatory minimum requirements for all municipal emergency management programs as set out in the regulations of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act.

Development of Arthur Street in Port Albert

Following a delegation by landowners, Council agreed to proceed with the Port Albert Servicing Master Plan and initiate the process for the construction of the unopened portion of Arthur Street as requested by landowners.

Election Results 2022

Council was presented with the election results from the 2022 Municipal and School Board election. Mayor Glen McNeil, and CAO Mark Becker wished farewell to outgoing Deputy Mayor Roger Watt and Councillor Gloria Fisher.

Lakeshore Curbside Waste Collection Pilot Project

Council agreed to extend the curbside pilot project for the summer of 2023, with two additional roads being added to the project at the discretion of the Public Works Superintendent.
