Council Meeting - November 7, 2023

2024 Tree Program

Council requested staff proceed with the yearly tree order as per the Township's policy, ordering 500 trees for 2024. More information on the 2024 Tree Program will be included in the 2024 Winter/Spring Newsletter.

2024-2026 Risk Management Official Servicing Agreement

Council adopted the authorizing by-law for the new Risk Management Official Servicing Agreement for municipalities required to implement Part IV policies of the Ausable Bayfield and Maitland Valley Source Protection Plans under the Clean Water Act, 2006.

Council Remuneration By-Law

Council agreed to a 0% increase for Council Remuneration for 2024.

Goderich Fire Committee - Fire Chief Vehicle

Council approved a request from the Goderich Fire Committee to purchase a dedicated Fire Chief vehicle in the amount of \$85,000. The purchase is to take place in 2023, with the funds to be taken from the Town of Goderich Reserve Funds.

Sommer Brothers - Isobel St. Passive Project

Jeremiah Sommers of Sommer Brothers construction presented to Council on the Isobel St. Passive Project. Following the presentation, Council allowed deferral of the Water Connection Fee and the Development Charges fee for the Isabel Street Passive Project until occupancy or one year, which ever comes first.

Short Term Rentals

Council approved the following motion:

That Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh Township Council direct Staff to develop a consultation process in order to identify issues which could be addressed by a Short-Term Rental regulatory program. The process should focus on discussions and consultations, based on research with other municipalities who have incorporated a STR licensing program. Consultations should be open to (but not limited to) STR operators, cottage associations, business owners, motel/hotel operators, neighbourhood groups, and emergency services.
