Regular Council Meeting– October 4, 2022

Fall Tree Order

Council authorized the purchase of 350 trees for the 2023 Tree Planting Program. Tree sales will open at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, March 1, 2023. More information on the Tree Planting Program will be available in the 2023 Winter/Spring Newsletter.

Planning Public Meetings

Council agreed to meet the second Tuesday of each month, if necessary, at 7:00 p.m. for Public Meetings that are required for Planning Applications. These Planning Public Meetings will commence on December 13, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers.

2023 OPP Annual Billing Statement

Council was presented with the OPP municipal policing 2023 Annual Billing Statement package and a staff report. Under the current OPP cost-recovery billing model, all municipalities pay the same base service cost per property for proactive policing activities, plus an additional cost for reactive Calls for Service (CFS), as well as other charges, if applicable, such as overtime, accommodation, cleaning services, prisoner transportation, court security, enhancements, etc. The total estimated cost for 2023 is \$914,026.

Parking By-Law Amendment

Council adopted an amending by-law to add two new “No Parking Zones” to By-law 05-2013 being the Parking By-Law. The result of the passing of this by-law is that a “No Parking Zone” has been added for the area from the designated parking area at Ashfield Park Beach to the top of the bank on Zion Road. Additionally, a “No Parking Zone” has been added for the area from civic address 85246 MacKenzie Camp Road South to the top of the bank on MacKenzie Camp Road South. Special Council Meeting–October 18, 2022

Plan of Subdivision Application File 40T22005 & Zoning By-Law Amendment ACW Z06-22 Zelinka Priamo Ltd.

A Public Meeting was held for the purpose of obtaining input from members of the public on the draft Plan of Subdivision and Zoning By-law Amendment for the property known as 81316 Westmount Line, Saltford.

The zoning by-law amendment application, if approved, would change the zoning on the subject lands to facilitate the development of 26 lots proposed for single detached residences, a storm water management block, and a road. The corresponding plan of subdivision application (County of Huron file # 40T22005) for the subject lands was considered as well.
