BY-LAW NUMBER 49-2012

BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT A ROADS GRANT POLICY FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF ASHFIELD-COLBORNE-WAWANOSH.

WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh deems it expedient to establish a Roads Grant Policy for Lakefront Association Unassumed Roads.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh enacts as follows:

- 1. The Corporation of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh hereby adopts the Roads Grant Policy contained in the attached Schedule 'A' to this by-law.
- 2. The By-law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
- 3. This By-law may be cited as the 'Roads Grant Policy By-law.'


SECTION: Public Works **POLICY:** Roads Grant

COVERAGE: Lakefront Association Unassumed Roads

Policy Statement:

- 1. The grant is available for unassumed roads that were created by Plan of Subdivision or by Reference Plan regardless of the ownership of the road.
- 2. The road must be open to the public. There cannot be any "No Trespassing" or "Private Road" signs.
- 3. There must be a formal lakefront association with an executive, constitution, by-laws and bank account. This information must be provided to the Township Office. The cheques will be payable to the lakefront association, not an individual.
- 4. The grant can be used by a lakefront association for maintenance of the roads, such as grading, snow plowing, gravel, calcium, grass cutting, drainage, including ditch work and catch basins, road construction, and hard surfacing of the roadways.
- 5. The intention of the grant is to assist private associations with the maintenance and repairs of unassumed roads and it is understood the Township is not responsible for assuming the road.
- 6. The allotment is 30% of the total eligible expenses to a maximum of \$800 per kilometre.

Note: The allotment is 30% of the total eligible expenses to a maximum of \$800 per kilometre.

Submission is due on or before November 30th of the current year. Supporting, paid invoices must be attached to this schedule. Failure to do so will result in that expense being ineligible to qualify for reimbursement.

Association must apply every year in order to receive a grant. Non-submission in a year will result in loss of eligible amount for that year.

Cheques will be issued to the Association and mailed to the address indicated on the next page.
