Tender for Calcium Chloride and/or Magnesium Chloride Equivalent

- 1. This TENDER is **due** on or before **January 30, 2025 at 1:00p.m.**
- 2. Price quoted shall be per Flake Ton minimum 35% **Calcium Chloride and/or Magnesium Chloride Equivalent,** supplied and applied as per OPSS 506. A Flake Ton is considered to be 77% strength Calcium Chloride.
- 3. The bidder's truck must be capable of accurately controlling the application rate from one and a half (1 ½) Flake Ton to four (4) Flakes Tons per mile. The product will be applied in a single application.
- 4. Bidders must be able to supply up to thirty-five (35) Flake Ton per day if given one (1) days notice.
- 5. All delivery costs shall be included in the unit price. The Township takes ownership of the product upon delivery completion at the designated Township site.
- 6. Samples may be taken by the Township Public Works Superintendent or Lead Hand for testing purposes.
- 7. Please provide confirmation from references as to the products quality and longevity.

Standard Clauses

The following clauses shall form part of any tender specification prepared by Township Staff for works to be built and/or constructed in the Municipality.

LIABILITY INSURANCE

The Contractor shall take out and keep in force until the date of acceptance of the entire work by the municipality, a comprehensive policy of public liability and property damage insurance acceptable to the Municipality providing insurance coverage in respect of any one accident to the limit of at least \$5,000,000 (five million) dollars, exclusive of interest and cost against loss or damage to property and such policy shall name The Corporation of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh as an additional insured thereunder and shall protect the Corporation of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh against all claims for all damage or injury including death to any person or persons and for damage to any property of the Municipality or any other public or private property resulting from or arising out of any act or omission on the part of the Contractor or any of his servants or agents during the execution of the contract and the Contractor shall forward a certified copy of the policy or certificate thereof to the municipality before the work is started.

PROTECTION OF EXISTING WORKS

The contractor shall ensure that no damage is caused to any existing works. The contractor shall be responsible for all damage claims which are alleged to be due to the work performed under this contract or order.

CONTRACTORS RISK

The contractor shall assume full responsibility as to the public safety, public liability and property damage, and his workmen shall be covered by workmen's compensation. In addition, work will conform to the requirements of the occupational Health and Safety Act, and Regulations under this Act.
