CONDITIONS:

While undertaking the work described on this permit, the applicant must:

- 1. Obtain the location of all underground utilities prior to excavating and protect these utilities.
 - **2.** Assume responsibility for any claims against the Corporation as a result of the excavation work. The applicant must carry \$5,000,000 general liability insurance to protect the corporation during this period.
 - 3. Barricade and sign all excavation sites in accordance with the requirements of the Highway Traffic Act.
 - **4.** The Contractor shall be completely responsible for always maintaining a safe workplace.

The Contractor shall ensure that all employees are aware of the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act.

5. Notify the Public Works Superintendent at least 3 days in advance of beginning any work.

RESTORATIONS:

a) Roadways

	Reinstate the excavated trench to original or better condition
	☐ Repair the road cut with a minimum of 75mm HL3 Hot Mix Asphalt over 450mm of compacted Granular "A" ☐ Cold mix asphalt shall be temporarily placed in the road cut if there is a delay in placing hot mix asphalt
	b) Boulevards and Easements
☐ Reinstate the excavated trench to original or better condition	
	☐ Lawns shall be restored with sod over a 75mm layer of topsoil
	\square All other areas shall be restored to match existing ground cover
	c) Sidewalk
☐ Reinstate the excavated sidewalk to original or better condition	
	☐ All concrete to be 150mm thick and 32Mpa and must be replaced within a reasonable amount of time from initial removals
	☐ Any sidewalk removed at a driveway entrance will follow OPSD 310.05.
	d) Maintain all the restoration for a period of one year

- **e)** Compensate the Corporation for any expenses incurred in connection with this work, such as the cost of engineering design, inspection personnel, labour, materials, equipment rental, etc.
- **f)** If the applicant fails to complete the work to the satisfaction of Public Works Superintendent, the Corporation shall complete the work and all costs incurred shall be charged to the applicant.
