<u>Due to replacement of a water line there will be a loss of pressure. Due to this loss of pressure we are required to issue a precautionary boil water notice.</u>	
Please take the following precautions:	
□ drink	r water at a rolling boil for at least ONE MINUTE before using it to:
□ wash f□ make i	, brush your teeth or rinse dentures ruits, vegetables or other food ce, juices, puddings or other mixes paby food or formula
•	also use bottled water instead of boiled water for the above-mentioned uses. bathing, showering, laundry, dishwashing can be carried out as usual.
This precautionary Boil Water Notice will be in effect until the water has been sampled and tested as free from bacteria. Results may take several days.
