Community Onsite Septic Inspection Program Appoints Septic Inspectors

Council appointed Dean Dobrianskyj, Victoria Lucas, Paisley McDowell, Alana Hollander, and Michael Varty as Septic Inspectors for ACW to execute the new Community Onsite Septic Inspection Program. Short-Term Rental Update

Council requested staff to prepare a proposed Terms of Reference for a Committee of Council whose mandate would be to make a recommendation to Council on a draft licencing by-law to regulate Short-Term Rentals within the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh.

100 Radon Test Kit Challenge

Council supports participating in the 100 Radon Test Kit Challenge. Radon is a radioactive gas which comes from the soil or rock due to the breakdown of uranium. It is invisible, odourless and tasteless and enters all buildings which have contact with the ground. Radon is the leading cause of Lung Cancer in non-smokers and greatly increases a smoker's risk of getting lung cancer. The program is free with all the resources provided and is expected to launch in October/November. Watch the website for more information about this upcoming program.

Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) Agreement

Council approved entering into the renewed Municipal Funding Agreement between the Association of Municipalities Ontario and the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh for the transfer of Canada Community-Building Fund for the ten-year period from April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2034. Council passed a by-law authorizing the CAO and Treasurer to execute the new Municipal Funding Agreement on behalf of the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh.

Since 2005, ACW has received \$3.2 million in CCBF which has been used to complete \$2.9 million in projects related to local roads and bridges.

AMO provided the Township with a renewed 10-year MFA for the administration of the CCBF. The funding agreement runs from 2024 to 2034 providing stability for financial planning. The Township has been provided allocations from the fund as follows:

The funds provided may be used as the Township sees fit provided it meets the eligibility criteria, there is no application required to access the funds. The list of eligible investment categories remains unchanged.

Since 2005, the Canada Community-Building Fund has been a reliable source of grant funding for the Township to support new infrastructure initiatives and renewal of existing assets. The renewed MFA specifies an additional ten years of funding, providing stability in long-term financial planning for capital reinvestment and asset management.
