Minor Variance Application File MV-2024-11 Knight

The Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh Committee of Adjustment approved the Minor Variance Application MV-2024-11 Knight subject to the conditions noted in the Planner's Report.

#### Waste Management Delegation

Luiza Adsett, Senior Manager of Public Affairs with Waste Management presented Council with a proposal for Curbside Collection of Waste. Starting in May 2025, Waste Management will continue to handle the Township's recycling pickup, following the transition to extended producer responsibility. Waste Management was the only contractor to bid on the Township's catchment area for this service. This recycling pickup will be provided at no cost, but the Township will no longer receive funding to support the Blue Box program. The contract for waste pickup will be presented at a future Council Meeting for formal authorization.

#### Benmiller Baseball Program Update

There was success in recruiting volunteers for the 2025 Benmiller Softball Program, and that the program will proceed as planned with the support of the newly recruited team. #### Special Council Meeting - Budget | MARCH 14, 2025

#### 2025 Proposed Budget

Staff presented Council with the proposed 2025 budget. Council instructed staff to make the few minor amendments to the draft budget. Council agreed to a 2.75% increase to the 2024 tax rate, which converts to a 5% increase in the municipal levy from 2024, which raises an additional \$329,207. Based on the average assessment of a single family detached home for 2025, and comparing it to the assessment for 2024, the average single family detached home will see an increase of \$49 for the 2025 year over 2024.
