Animal Licensing

Effective January 1, 2022, dog owners are no longer required to purchase municipal dog tags for their pets. Identification by means of microchip or other tag is required to make sure your pet makes it home if it gets lost. By-Law 38-2021 being the "Animal Control By-law" remains in effect and continues to regulate animal care and control within the Municipality.

2022 Interim Taxes

Due March 31st & June 30th

Tax Payments must be received by the due date. Failure to receive a tax notice does not exempt you from the payment of taxes, nor penalty and interest.

Hours of Operation:

April – November: Monday & Saturday
9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

December – March: Saturday
9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

All household recycling must be disposed of through curbside collection, it is no longer be accepted at the landfill.

A minimum charge of \$10 per load of waste will apply.

2022 Tree Program

The Township purchases trees from the Maitland Valley Conservation Authority (MVCA) and makes them available for distribution to property owners who request a tree or trees. Each landowner is limited to five trees each year, at a cost of \$10 per tree. The property owner must pickup, plant, and maintain the trees. The Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh accepts no responsibility for the trees after pickup.

New this year: tree sales open on Tuesday, March 1, 2022, at 8:30 a.m. You can purchase your trees by calling or visiting the Municipal Office. Trees are first come first serve and there is a limited quantity of each variety. This year we offer the following varieties: Sugar Maple, Native Red, Red Oak and Bur Oak.

Municipal Election 2022

Every four years, a Municipal Election is held to elect members of Council. This year Voting Day will take place on Monday, October 24, 2022, and a new term of Council begins on November 15, 2022.

The municipal council in the Township of Ashfield-Colborne-Wawanosh controls a 14-million-dollar budget and makes decisions on the municipal services that are provided to residents and ratepayers. The council you elect will determine the strategic direction of the municipality for the next four years.

Voters Information

Who can vote in the Municipal Election?

You are eligible to vote in the Municipal Election if, on voting day, you:

- Reside in the local municipality or are the owner or tenant of land here, or the spouse of an owner or tenant AND
- Are a Canadian citizen AND
- Are at least 18 years old AND
- Are not prohibited from voting by law.

Your name must be on the voters' list for you to cast a ballot.

Who can I vote for in a Municipal Election?

On a Municipal Election ballot, you will see candidates running for:

- Mayor AND
- Deputy Mayor AND

- School Trustee (depending on your school support)
