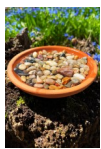

## Let's Paint!

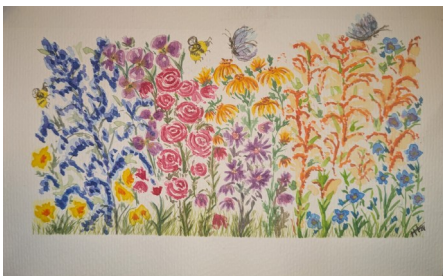

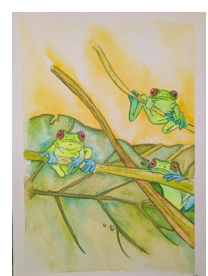

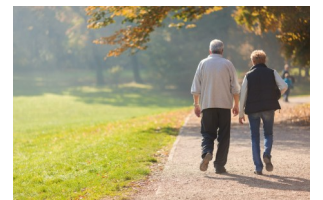
## **Let's Keep Moving!**
